


CONTENTS AND USAGE OF THE BOOK

In our book we introduce recurring plate flaws we have discovered on 4 stamps from the line titled Landscapes-Cities (II.). This includes 752 repeated plate flaws and 211 errors identified by the sheet location of the stamp. The book illustrates each error (or EFO) together with a photograph. In view of the estimated big size of the issue it is highly likely that further repetitions will be discovered. Of course the authors also have several other errors the pair of which is not known at the moment. Unfortunately, during our research for these four stamps we were unable to get any data on the number of pieces issued by the post office. The issues are characterized by multiple reprintings, several paper types and as a result: several shades. For each issue we found 1 type of printed sheet. In these sheets the 2 postal sheets with the 100 stamp places are above each other. The upper sheet is marked by A, the bottom sheet is marked by B. Furthermore, we have also found different postal sheets of size 100, which we have marked using the letters of the alphabet. Between these sheets there is no such connection as between sheets A and B.

First of all, we introduce all values based on *The catalogue of Hungarian stamps*. Also, we give a percentage, which shows how many differences we have found for that given stamp. After such introduction we introduce the repeated plate errors of the given stamp, identified by the location in the postal sheet. The first column of the chart contains the code of the photograph, based on which it can be identified among the images. The second column contains the location of the given image in the sheet, together with the indication of the sheet. The third column contains a short description of the error. The fourth column shows the scores value

in points. Here we provide the value of the stamped stamp. 1 point = 100 HUF In the fifth column you can give your own valuation.

Throughout the establishment of the evaluation process we strived to take into account as many factors as possible. However, we also would like to draw your attention to the fact that for each stamp we have provided a percentage indicating the amount of plate error differences we found. This percentage shows that among stamps printed with the same technology the same errors appear with a 2 or 4 times difference. Logically this would mean that the same error on a rarer stamp has a 4 times higher value. But in our view this should be decided by the market and the collectors. Here we note the following: in 100,000 pieces we only found 2 very beautiful plate flaws. For 1,000,000 pieces this means 20 pieces. Here we did not undertake to give an accurate valuation, instead we just chose to give an „EÉ” marking . In the case of stamps on a postal document we recommend a 1-3 times multiplier, depending on the magnitude of the error. In the case of the so-called mint stamps (that is unused stamps), but for a few exceptions, we recommend a 1-10 times multiplier, depending on the type of error.

We think that because of the several reprintings mint stamps represent specialities. For instance how likely it is to find just another specimen of error 100/66/C from the 1986 series of „Esztergom”, besides the mint stamp exhibited in the Stamp museum?

After the charts showing the errors identified by the location in the sheet, in groups we introduce errors typical of one location. E.g. errors found in the „Magyar Posta” (Hungarian Post) inscription. 8 images per page identified by the appropriate code, in 2 columns. Below 2 images next to each other with the respective 2 rows in the chart. Occasionally we also mark the image (in order to make clear what the error is).
